Ronald Duane Bricks, 75, a title examiner and Navy veteran, died of heart failure Monday June 23, 2008 at his home in Shelby.

Survivors include his wife of 52 years, Lois Bricks of Shelby; daughter Karen (Dale) Hamre of Selby, S.D.; son David Bricks of Littleton, Colo.; grandchildren Steven, John and Eli; brothers Richard Bricks of Highwood, Robert Bricks of Great Falls and Gene (Kathi) Bricks of Plantation, Fla.; as well as numerous nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents.

Ron was born Jan. 7, 1933, to Joseph and Mabel (Quade) Bricks in Great Falls, where he grew up and graduated from high school in 1951. That same year he joined the U.S. Navy, serving during the Korean Conflict, and was discharged in June 1955.

He married Lois Giske on May 12, 1956, at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Great Falls.

He started in the title business in Great Falls in 1959 and then transferred to Kalispell. From 1964 to 1966, he worked back in Great Falls before moving to Sidney in 1981. Then in 1989 he moved to Lewistown and in 1993 he moved to Shelby as manager of the title company until he retired in 2004.

Ron was a great Mr. Fix-it and was always tinkering with gadgets, repairing cars and

small appliances and working in the yard. He was always ready to lend a helping hand to those in need.

Besides being an avid golfer, Ron also enjoyed watching old western movies, square dancing, hunting, fishing, camping and anything to do with the outdoors. He had been an active member of both the Trinity and Peace Lutheran churches in Great Falls in his early years. He also was a member of the Marias Valley Golf & Country Club, Lions Club, Kiwanis, Elks, Eagles and local community theater.
